Bluepoint adopts local San Diego School for Homeless and Disadvantaged Youth.

July 5, 2006, SAN DIEGO, CA - Bluepoint Solutions, a San Diego based Credit Union software developer, continues to be committed to the Monarch School, a local San Diego school that is dedicated to helping homeless and at-risk children and adolescents improve their lives and outlook.

The Monarch School provides a setting where homeless children, ages 8 to 18 can explore and achieve their dreams of normal, productive lives. Ancillary programs such as family assistance, job training, counseling, medical support, and personal enrichment through one-on-one mentoring are provided. The school also supports these children with basic survival needs such as food, clothing and health care.

The San Diego county Office of Education provides approximately 50% of Monarch's funding by covering basic education elements of the school - teachers, aides, instruction materials, etc.

Beyond county funding, The Monarch School relies on community support to continue their work. Bluepoint Solutions donates 5% of all company profits to the Monarch School. In addition, Bluepoint Solutions CEO, Hal Tilbury has committed his employees to 50 days of "during work hours" volunteer time at the school.

Most recently, Bluepoint employees organized and visited the school to assist students in craft projects for both Mother's and Father's day. "We had a great turnout of students for both projects," commented Anne Wenger, Bluepoint Solution's activities and fundraiser coordinator.

In addition to their 50 days of commitment with the children, Bluepoint is also conducting a fundraising event to help raise additional monies for The Monarch School. Bluepoint is selling raffle tickets in conjunction with a program called Football Mania (www.charitymania.com). Football Mania is a fundraiser that revolves around the NFL football season. Each ticket represents a chance to win up to \$500, every week, for 17 weeks during the football season. This fundraising even is fun for everyone who participates and is s great opportunity to raise much needed funds for The Monarch School.
